Job Description

Works with program supervisor to anticipate foster parent recruitment needs. Selects method of advertising, prepares and places recruitment ads. Recruits, trains, and facilitates certification of foster parents. Conducts initial and follow-up training of foster parents. Serves as resource and trouble shooter to foster families; maintains motivation and treatment participation of foster parents, ensures good working relationship with foster parents. Conducts structured telephone interviews with foster parents on program youth behaviors and foster family stress (PDR), on a daily basis (5 days/week). Provides PDR data to program supervisors and program staff. Organizes and attends/co-facilitates weekly foster parent meetings. Attends weekly clinical team meetings.

Experience Necessary

Must have completed the Tier One Assessor Training. Experience or familiarity with foster parenting, preferably in a therapeutic foster care setting. Background in an area relevant to the mental health field preferred. Experience in teaching or instructional presentations preferred. Development of a thorough understanding of and enthusiasm toward the MTFC model. Detail orientation, clerical aptitude. Excellent interpersonal skills. Excellent verbal communications skills. Excellent organizational skills. Ability to function well in a team setting. Ability to work independently. Valid driver's license, reliable car, and adequate automobile liability insurance.

Minimum of an undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university in the field of counseling or social work. Possession of a valid social work or counselor license issued by the appropriate licensing authority.
